## **SENATE BILL No. 1352**

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act," by amending sections 80177 and 80178 (MCL 324.80177 and 324.80178), as added by 1995 PA 58.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 80177. (1) If a person is convicted of violating sec-

- 22 (ii) Imprisonment for not more than  $\frac{-90}{}$  93 days.
- 23 (iii) A fine of not more than \$300.00.
- 24 (b) If the violation occurs within 7 years of 1 prior con-
- 25 viction, the person shall be sentenced to both a fine of not less
- 26 than \$200.00 or more than \$1,000.00, and either of the

- 1 (i) Community service for not less than 10 days or more than
- ${f 2}$  90 days, and may be sentenced to imprisonment for not more than 1
- 3 year.
- 4 (ii) Imprisonment for not more than 1 year, and may be sen-
