A bill to amend 1965 PA 166, entitled

"An act to require prevailing wages and fringe benefits on state projects; to establish the requirements and responsibilities of contracting agents and bidders; and to prescribe penalties,"

by amending section 1 (MCL 408.551).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 2 (a) "Construction mechanic" means a skilled or unskilled

- 4 ing on a state project. but shall CONSTRUCTION MECHANIC DOES

- 7 (b) "State project" means new construction, alteration,

- 1 public buildings, schools, EXCEPT A PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY, works,
- 2 bridges, highways, or roads authorized by a contracting agent.
- 3 (c) "Contracting agent" means any officer, school board,

- 5 supported in whole or in part by state funds, authorized to enter
- 6 into a contract for a state project or to perform a state project
- 7 by the direct employment of labor. CONTRACTING AGENT DOES NOT
