## SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION V

September 21, 2000, Introduced by Senator JAYE and referred to the Committee on Natural Resources and Environmental Affairs.

A joint resolution proposing an amendment to the state constitution of 1963, by adding section 27 to article I, to recognize a right to access natural resources.

Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives of the state of Michigan, That the following amendment to the state constitution of 1963, to recognize a right to access natural resources, is proposed, agreed to, and submitted to the people of the state:

- 1 ARTICLE I
- SEC. 27. THE PEOPLE HAVE THE RIGHT TO ACCESS NATURAL
- 3 RESOURCES, SUBJECT ONLY TO RESTRICTIONS ON METHODS, SEASONS,
- 4 TIMES, AND LOCATIONS OF ACCESS THAT ARE PRESCRIBED BY LAW AND
- 5 NECESSARY FOR PUBLIC SAFETY OR THE CONSERVATION OR ENHANCEMENT OF
- 6 THE NATURAL RESOURCES OF THE STATE.
