

SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION V

September 21, 2000, Introduced by Senator JAYE and referred to the Committee on Natural Resources and Environmental Affairs.

A joint resolution proposing an amendment to the state constitution of 1963, by adding section 27 to article I, to recognize a right to access natural resources.

Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives of the state of Michigan, That the following amendment to the state constitution of 1963, to recognize a right to access natural resources, is proposed, agreed to, and submitted to the people of the state:

ARTICLE I

SEC. 27. THE PEOPLE HAVE THE RIGHT TO ACCESS NATURAL RESOURCES, SUBJECT ONLY TO RESTRICTIONS ON METHODS, SEASONS, TIMES, AND LOCATIONS OF ACCESS THAT ARE PRESCRIBED BY LAW AND NECESSARY FOR PUBLIC SAFETY OR THE CONSERVATION OR ENHANCEMENT OF THE NATURAL RESOURCES OF THE STATE.

1 Resolved further, That the foregoing amendment shall be
