The bill allows a nonprofit fraternal organization incorporated under the laws of this state and whose membership is not totally composed of law enforcement personnel or public officeholders charged with enforcing any penal laws or ordinances of a government body to be issued a Class C liquor license, if the organization is otherwise qualified. Under current law, these organizations are allowed to be issued club liquor licenses only if they have members who are law enforcement personnel or public officeholders. While the bill may expand eligibility for Class C licenses, it would have no fiscal impact given the statutory quota on the number of Class C licenses available statewide.
