House Bill 4822 would amend the Michigan Vehicle Code to require a child between 40 and 80 pounds, who is 4 feet 9 inches or shorter, the child being between the ages of 4 and 8 years, in a moving motor vehicle, to be seated in a manufacturer certified booster seat and secured by a seat belt.

There would be additional costs to motor vehicle operators for the purchase of a booster seat, but no additional costs directly associated to state or local governments by this bill. However, this bill is tie-barred to House Bill 4821which addresses possible civil fines. There are indeterminate costs and revenues to local units of government due to amended language in House Bill 4821.
