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House Bill 5211 would amend the General Property Tax Act by allowing local units to provide to a taxpayer the option of filing a statement of personal property owned electronically. Under current law, a supervisor or other assessing officer is required to notify an individual who owns personal property to submit a written statement of all personal property owned by that person. HB5211 would allow the taxpayer to file such a statement electronically if a local units provides that option.

As written, HB5211 would have no direct state fiscal impact. There may be a small cost to a local unit of implementing a system that would allow electronic filing.
