House Bill 5274 would amend The Code of Criminal Procedure to require that a police officer provide the victim of a crime committed by an individual with whom he or she has had a dating relationship with a notice stating, among other things, the victim's legal rights with respect to the incident in which the crime was committed. Given that this would apply an existing statutory requirement to a set of crimes similar in nature to crimes currently covered by the requirement, it would have no direct fiscal impact on state or local government.

The bill would also require the Department of State Police to develop a standard domestic violence incident report form to be used by police officers to comply with the statutory reporting requirement for such incidents. This provision would be unlikely to result in significant costs for the department.
