The bill would amend the Code of Criminal Procedure generally to prohibit bond for someone who was arrested for violation of a personal protection order (PPO) and who had previously been convicted of aggravated stalking. Bond could be set if the court found by clear and convincing evidence that the individual posed no danger to others. The bill could increase local correctional costs to the extent that offenders who might have been released on bond were instead kept in jail until the hearing on the PPO violation.
