The bill would amend the Code of Criminal Procedure to allow, under certain conditions, the introduction of evidence of prior acts of domestic violence on the part of a person accused of committing an act of domestic violence or violating a domestic relations personal protection order. The bill would have no direct fiscal implications for the state or local units of government, although it could enable additional convictions to be obtained, which would tend to increase state and local correctional costs.
