A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4544 AS INTRODUCED 3-28-01

The bill would amend the Michigan Vehicle Code to increase the penalty for illegally parking in a parking space that is clearly identified as reserved for the use of disabled persons. The current penalty is a fine of no less than \$50 and no more than \$100. The bill would increase the amount of the fine to \$150.
