A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 5963 AS INTRODUCED 4-25-02

The bill would amend the Child Protection Law (Public Act 238 of 1975) to require the Family Independence Agency (FIA) to submit a quarterly report to the legislature regarding the number of child abuse or neglect reports received, listed by county, and the number of those reports that were assigned for investigation; the number of assigned referrals, listed by district and caseworker; and the number of opened cases, listed by case worker. The report would be submitted to the House and Senate appropriations subcommittee on the FIA, the House and Senate committees with jurisdiction over human services matters, the House and Senate Fiscal Agencies, and the House and Senate Policy offices.
