SCHOOL ELECTIONS

Senate Bill 438 would amend the Revised School Code to require that all elections adhere to the Michigan Election Law, which provides for the regulation of State and local elections. SB 438 specifies the dates on which elections can be held, allows school districts to reimburse local units of government for election costs, and requires local school districts and intermediate school districts to provide an estimate of the cost of repaying bonds to the public. This bill has no State fiscal impact. Local units of government could realize an indeterminate amount of revenues from school elections.
