SUMMARY

Senate Bill 440 would amend the Michigan Election Law to make requirements as to when regular school and local elections could be held, it provides for the calling, administering and canvassing school elections, and requires a school district election coordinator for a school district to conduct all regular and special school elections. The bill would also create in each school district an election coordinating committee.

There would be no fiscal impact on state government. Local government and schools may incur some additional administrative costs, but these are indeterminate.
