SUMMARY

Senate Bill 1202 would amend the Charter Township Act to provide that a referendum regarding the annexation of a portion of a township by a village or city would have to be held in the county at least 60 days after the validation of the annexation petition, or in compliance with the Michigan Election Law. The Michigan Election Law may be amended by Senate Bill 439 (S-2) as passed by the Senate, to specify the dates upon which certain elections could be held in the State.

The bill would have no fiscal impact on State or local units of government.
