### SUMMARY

Senate Bill 1391 would amend the Michigan Vehicle Code to allow physician's assistants to certify that a person is disabled for the purposes of obtaining a windshield placard or a free parking sticker. Currently, only licensed physicians (or, in the case of blindness, licensed optometrists) may certify.

The bill would have no fiscal impact on State or local government.
