## **SUMMARY**

House Bills 5389 through 5393 constitute a package of bills that would divide felony sentencing guidelines into a larger number of statutory sections, thus reducing the need for "conflict" substitute bills necessitated by recent amendments to an affected section of law. The bills would make no substantive changes to the guidelines, and therefore would have no significant fiscal implications for the state or local units of government.
