SUMMARY

House Bill 5501 would amend the Michigan Military Act to expand civil and criminal liability to certain military personnel called into service to respond to acts or threats of terrorism. In addition, the bill would expand the duties of the adjutant general, who serves as the director of the Department of Military and Veterans Affairs. The bill would have no direct fiscal impact on the state or local governments.
