SUMMARY

HB 6204 would amend the Child Protection Law by allowing the Family Independence Agency to provide documentation, upon written request from an individual applying to work or volunteer in a child care center, stating that the individual is not named as a perpetrator of child abuse or neglect in the Central Registry. The legislation would also allow the Family Independence Agency to develop an automated system to provide public access to a list of individuals applying to work or volunteer in child care centers not named in the Central Registry.

It appears HB 6204 would have an indeterminate impact on state costs. The legislation would require the Family Independence Agency to collect and respond to additional requests for information and would allow for the development of an automated system, increasing administration costs.
