SUMMARY

The bill would amend the Correctional Officers' Training Act of 1982 to make it consistent with HB 5977, which would create the Local Corrections Officers Training Act. Language requiring the correctional officers' training council to develop minimum standards for local correctional officers would be replaced with language requiring the council to perform duties relating to local correctional officer certification and the operation of the local corrections officers advisory council (which would be created by HB 5977). In addition, the council would be increased from 10 to 11 members through increasing the number of deputy sheriff representatives from one to two. The bill would have no significant impact on the state or local units of government.
