SUMMARY

HB 6552 includes language consistent with current policy and statute related to the retention and distribution of child support payments for children committed to or under the supervision of the Family Independence Agency. The legislation also removes the 20% cap on child care fund expenditures for early intervention and in-home services. The fiscal impact is indeterminate. In fiscal year 2001, the in-home and early intervention expenditures fell below the 20% cap. However, if counties have more flexibility to utilize community-based in-home services, expenditures could decrease over time.
