- Hiring Freeze. The House added language exempting the Animal Industry Program from the State classified hiring freeze. (Sec. 205)
- 2. Buy Michigan. The House added language on "buy Michigan" in addition to "buy American" language. (Sec. 209)
- 3. Indemnification Payments. The House added language to provide for retroactive payments at 100% of fair market value up to \$4,000 for animals destroyed between 01/01/98 and 10/31/00. (Sec. 212)
- **Budgetary Savings.** The House added language requiring legislative transfers to apply the budgetary savings (\$241,600) to the appropriate line items. (Sec. 220)
