CONTENT

The bill would amend the Insurance Code by replacing the words "Public Service Commission" with "Department of Transportation" in a subsection detailing personal protection benefits. According to the Act, a passenger riding in a bus operated by "a common carrier of passengers certified by the *public service commission*" (emphasis added) is not eligible for personal protection benefits, unless he or she is not entitled to benefits under any other policy. The bill would refer to a common carrier certified by the Department.
