

## House Boilerplate Changes from FY 2002-03 Senate-Passed:

- 1. **Luxury Vehicles.** Prohibit State appropriation expenditures for lease or purchase of luxury vehicles or chauffeur services for university officials. (Sec. 217)
- 2. Capital Outlay. Legislative intent that State-funded capital outlay projects are competitively bid. (Sec. 218)
- 3. **Kendall College.** Clarify that only students enrolled in Kendall College programs at Ferris are eligible for tuition grants. (Sec. 302(7))
- 4. **Nursing Scholarship Program.** Substitute Michigan Board of Nursing for Higher Education Assistance Authority as program administrator; include licensed practical, associate degree, and bachelor's degree nursing programs; allow unexpended funds to carry-forward; and require that enacted statutory provisions would supercede boilerplate. (Sec. 312)
- 5. **Joseph F. Young, Sr. Psychiatric Research and Training Program.** Earmark 25% of the funds for treatment of adolescents in southeastern Michigan. (Sec. 401)
- 6. **Funding Floors.** Remove Senate-passed single floor of \$4,500 per-student, and reinsert FY 2001-02 university groupings with four floors of \$4,600, \$4,800, \$5,800, and \$9,100. (Sec. 409)
- 7. Rare Isotope Accelerator. Legislative intent that Michigan State University collaborate with the MEDC to develop program statement and preliminary design documents. (Sec. 437)
- 8. **Consensus Revenue Estimating Conference.** Legislative intent that if the Conference determines additional revenue is available, funds would be appropriated based on House's four per-student floors, rather than the Senate's single floor of \$4,500. (Sec. 438)
- 9. **Postsecondary Enrollment Options Act.** Establish House/Senate work group to make recommendations on acceptance of college credits earned under the Act. (Sec. 439)
- 10. **HEIDI Data.** Require Auditor General to review data for all 15 universities rather than a randomly selected five. (Sec. 701)
- 11. New Degree Programs. Add new degrees recommended by the Presidents Council. (Sec. 701a)
