CONTENT

The bill would amend the General Sales Tax Act to eliminate the requirement that a person pay a \$1 registration fee when obtaining an annual sales tax license.

FISCAL IMPACT

The bill would reduce sales tax revenue by an estimated \$150,000 a year. This loss in revenue would affect State government by reducing School Aid Fund revenue \$110,000 and General Fund \$3,000. In addition, revenue sharing would be reduced \$37,000, which would have an impact on local governments.
