by amending the title and sections 1, 1a, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, and 7 (MCL 445.111, 445.111a, 445.112, 445.113, 445.114, 445.115, 445.116, and 445.117), section 1 as amended by 1999 PA 18 and sections 2 and 3 as amended by 2000 PA 15.

- 7 services of more than \$25.00 in which the seller or a person

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- 1 acting for the seller engages in a personal, telephonic,

- 3 tion is received by the buyer at a residence of the buyer, and
- 4 the buyer's agreement or offer to purchase is there given to the
- 5 seller or a person acting for the seller. Home solicitation sale
- 6 does not include any of the following:

- 8 account.
- 9 (ii) A sale made pursuant to prior negotiations between the
- 10 parties at a business establishment at a fixed location where
- 11 goods or services are offered or exhibited for sale.
- 12 (iii) A sale or solicitation of insurance by an insurance
- 13 agent licensed by the commissioner of insurance.
- 14 (iv) A sale made at a fixed location of a business estab-

- 17 (v) A sale made pursuant to a printed advertisement in a

- 19 (vi) A sale of services by a real estate broker or salesper-
- 20 son licensed by the department of consumer and industry

- 22 (vii) A sale of agricultural or horticultural equipment and

- (l) "PERSON" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL, PARTNERSHIP, CORPORATION,
- 4 LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY, ASSOCIATION, GOVERNMENTAL ENTITY, OR
- 5 OTHER LEGAL ENTITY.
- 6 (M) "RESIDENTIAL TELEPHONE SUBSCRIBER" MEANS A PERSON RESID-
- 7 ING IN THIS STATE WHO HAS RESIDENTIAL TELEPHONE SERVICE.
- 8 (N) "TELEPHONE SOLICITOR" MEANS ANY PERSON DOING BUSINESS IN
- 9 THIS STATE WHO MAKES OR CAUSES TO BE MADE A TELEPHONE SOLICITA-
- 10 TION FROM WITHIN OR OUTSIDE OF THIS STATE, INCLUDING, BUT NOT

- 13 (O) "TELEPHONE SOLICITATION" MEANS ANY VOICE COMMUNICATION

- 15 RENTAL OF, OR INVESTMENT IN, GOODS OR SERVICES. TELEPHONE SOLIC-
- 16 ITATION DOES NOT INCLUDE ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 17 (i) ANY VOICE COMMUNICATION TO ANY RESIDENTIAL TELEPHONE
- 18 SUBSCRIBER WITH THAT SUBSCRIBER'S PRIOR EXPRESS INVITATION OR

- 7 (2) Cancellation occurs when the buyer mails or delivers the
- 8 notice of cancellation provided for in section 3(2) or any other

- 10 stated in the notice of cancellation.
- 11 (3) A notice of cancellation or other written notice, if
- 12 mailed to the seller, is given when it is deposited in a mailbox
- 13 properly addressed and postage prepaid.
- 14 (4) A written notice or telegram given by the buyer other
- 15 than the notice of cancellation need not take a particular form
- 16 and is sufficient if it indicates by any form of written expres-
- 17 sion the intention of the buyer not to be bound by the home
- 18 solicitation sale OR TELEPHONE SOLICITATION SALE.
- 19 (5) A buyer may not cancel a home solicitation sale OR TELE-
- 20 PHONE SOLICITATION SALE if the buyer requests the seller to pro-
- 21 vide goods or services without delay because of an emergency, and
- 22 all of the following conditions are met:
- 23 (a) The seller in good faith makes a substantial beginning
- 24 of performance of the contract before the buyer gives notice of
- 25 cancellation.
- 26 (b) The buyer furnishes the seller with a separate dated and
- 27 signed personal statement in the buyer's handwriting describing

- 1 the situation requiring immediate remedy and expressly
- 2 acknowledging and waiving the right to cancel the sale within 3

- 3 business days.
- 4 (c) In the case of goods, the goods cannot be returned to
- 5 the seller in substantially as good condition as when received by
- 6 the buyer.
- 7 (6) If a home solicitation sale OR TELEPHONE SOLICITATION
- 8 SALE is also subject to the debtor's right to rescind certain
- 9 transactions, the buyer may proceed either under those provisions
- 10 or under this section.
- 11 Sec. 3. (1) In a home solicitation sale OR TELEPHONE SOLIC-
- 12 ITATION SALE, unless the buyer requests the seller to provide
- 13 goods or services without delay in an emergency, the seller shall
- 14 present to the buyer and obtain the buyer's signature to a writ-
- 15 ten agreement or offer to purchase that designates as the date of
- 16 the transaction the date on which the buyer actually signs.
- 17 The agreement or offer to purchase shall contain a statement
- 18 substantially as follows in immediate proximity to the space
- 19 reserved in the agreement or offer to purchase for the signature
- 20 of the buyer:
- 21 "You, the buyer, may cancel this transaction at any time
- 22 prior to midnight of the third business day after the date of
- 23 this transaction. See the attached notice of cancellation form
- 24 for an explanation of this right. Additionally, the seller is
- 25 prohibited from having an independent courier service or other
- 26 third party pick up your payment at your residence before the end
