HOUSE BILL NO. 4401

A bill to amend 1927 PA 175, entitled  
"The code of criminal procedure,"  
by amending section 2a of chapter IV (MCL 764.2a).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 CHAPTER IV

2 Sec. 2a. (1) A peace officer of a county, city, village,  
3 ~~or~~ township, OR UNIVERSITY of this state may exercise THE  
4 authority and powers ~~outside his own county, city, village, or~~  
5 ~~township, when he is enforcing the laws of this state in conjunc-~~  
6 ~~tion with the Michigan state police, or in conjunction with a~~  
7 ~~peace officer of the county, city, village, or township in which~~  
8 ~~he may be, the same as if he were in his own county, city, vil-~~  
9 ~~lage, or township.~~ OF A PEACE OFFICER OUTSIDE THE GEOGRAPHICAL  
10 BOUNDARIES OF THE OFFICER'S COUNTY, CITY, VILLAGE, TOWNSHIP, OR  
11 UNIVERSITY UNDER ANY OF THE FOLLOWING CIRCUMSTANCES:

1 (A) IF THE OFFICER IS ENFORCING THE LAWS OF THIS STATE IN  
2 CONJUNCTION WITH THE MICHIGAN STATE POLICE.

3 (B) IF THE OFFICER IS ENFORCING THE LAWS OF THIS STATE IN  
4 CONJUNCTION WITH A PEACE OFFICER OF ANY OTHER COUNTY, CITY, VIL-  
5 LAGE, TOWNSHIP, OR UNIVERSITY IN WHICH THE OFFICER MAY BE.

6 (C) IF THE OFFICER HAS WITNESSED AN INDIVIDUAL VIOLATE ANY  
7 OF THE FOLLOWING WITHIN THE GEOGRAPHICAL BOUNDARIES OF THE  
8 OFFICER'S COUNTY, CITY, VILLAGE, TOWNSHIP, OR UNIVERSITY AND  
9 IMMEDIATELY PURSUES THE INDIVIDUAL OUTSIDE OF THE GEOGRAPHICAL  
10 BOUNDARIES OF THE OFFICER'S COUNTY, CITY, VILLAGE, TOWNSHIP, OR  
11 UNIVERSITY:

12 (i) A STATE LAW OR ADMINISTRATIVE RULE.

13 (ii) A LOCAL ORDINANCE.

14 (iii) A STATE LAW, ADMINISTRATIVE RULE, OR LOCAL ORDINANCE,  
15 THE VIOLATION OF WHICH IS A CIVIL INFRACTION, MUNICIPAL CIVIL  
16 INFRACTION, OR STATE CIVIL INFRACTION.

17 (2) THE OFFICER PURSUING AN INDIVIDUAL UNDER  
18 SUBSECTION (1)(C) MAY STOP AND DETAIN THE PERSON OUTSIDE THE GEO-  
19 GRAPHICAL BOUNDARIES OF THE OFFICER'S COUNTY, CITY, VILLAGE,  
20 TOWNSHIP, OR UNIVERSITY FOR THE PURPOSE OF ENFORCING THAT LAW,  
21 ADMINISTRATIVE RULE, OR ORDINANCE OR ENFORCING ANY OTHER LAW,  
22 ADMINISTRATIVE RULE, OR ORDINANCE BEFORE, DURING, OR IMMEDIATELY  
23 AFTER THE DETAINING OF THE INDIVIDUAL. IF THE VIOLATION OR PUR-  
24 SUIT INVOLVES A VESSEL MOVING ON THE WATERS OF THIS STATE, THE  
25 OFFICER PURSUING THE INDIVIDUAL MAY DIRECT THE OPERATOR OF THE  
26 VESSEL TO BRING THE VESSEL TO A STOP OR MANEUVER IT IN A MANNER  
27 THAT PERMITS THE OFFICER TO COME BESIDE THE VESSEL.
