- 1 SEC. 2973. (1) A PERSON WHO INTENTIONALLY DAMAGES OR
- 2 DESTROYS ALL OR PART OF A FIELD CROP BELONGING TO ANOTHER PERSON
- 3 PRODUCED FOR CROP RESEARCH OR TESTING PURPOSES IS LIABLE IN A
- 4 CIVIL ACTION FOR DAMAGES AND COSTS AND FEES AS FURTHER DESCRIBED
- 5 IN SUBSECTION (2).
- 6 (2) THE COURT SHALL AWARD DAMAGES AS WELL AS COSTS AND FEES
- 7 ASSOCIATED WITH AN ACTION BROUGHT UNDER SUBSECTION (1) TO A PRE-
- 8 VAILING PLAINTIFF IN THE FOLLOWING AMOUNTS:
- 9 (A) TWICE THE MARKET VALUE OF THE FIELD CROP DAMAGED OR

- MENTALS, VEGETABLES, FRUIT, TURF, HORTICULTURAL CROPS, INDUSTRIAL 20
