SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 5210

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code,"

by amending section 811k (MCL 257.811k), as added by 2000 PA 73.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 811k. (1) The secretary of state shall develop under
- 2 section 811e and, upon application, may issue under section 811f
- 3 a state-sponsored lighthouse fund-raising registration plate and
- 4 a matching state-sponsored lighthouse fund-raising collector
- 5 plate as provided under section 811g. The plate shall be of a
- 6 design as determined by the secretary of state AFTER CONSULTATION
- 7 WITH THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HISTORY, ARTS, AND
- 8 LIBRARIES.
- **9** (2) The Michigan lighthouse preservation grant fund is
- 10 created as a separate fund in the department of treasury. The
- 11 fund shall be expended only as provided in this section. The

- 1 state treasurer may receive money or other assets from any source
- 2 for deposit into the fund. The state treasurer shall direct the
- 3 investment of the fund. The state treasurer shall credit to the
- 4 fund interest and earnings from fund investments. The state
- 5 treasurer shall annually present to the *secretary of state*
- 6 DEPARTMENT OF HISTORY, ARTS, AND LIBRARIES an accounting of the
- 7 amount of money in the fund. Money in the fund at the close of
- 8 the fiscal year shall remain in the fund and shall not lapse to
- 9 the general fund.
- 10 (3) The secretary of state DEPARTMENT OF HISTORY, ARTS,
- 11 AND LIBRARIES shall administer the fund and may expend money from
- 12 the fund through discretionary historical grants to preserve
- 13 Michigan lighthouses. The secretary of state DEPARTMENT OF
- 14 HISTORY, ARTS, AND LIBRARIES shall not use -not- more than 10% of
- 15 the funds for the secretary of state's costs OF THE DEPARTMENT
- 16 OF HISTORY, ARTS, AND LIBRARIES that occur from fund administra-
- 17 tion and grant project coordination.
- 18 (4) The secretary of state DEPARTMENT OF HISTORY, ARTS,
- 19 AND LIBRARIES may award grants for the preparation of plans and
- 20 specifications for restoration and stabilization and for stabili-
- 21 zation, rehabilitation, or other preservation work on a Michigan
- 22 lighthouse, but grants shall not be awarded for operational
- 23 purposes. The secretary of state DEPARTMENT OF HISTORY, ARTS,
- 24 AND LIBRARIES shall allocate grant funds pursuant to eligibility
- 25 and scoring requirements established by the secretary of state
- 26 DEPARTMENT OF HISTORY, ARTS, AND LIBRARIES. To award grants

- 1 HISTORY, ARTS, AND LIBRARIES shall solicit applications from
- 2 eligible recipients, score applications based on the established
- 3 criteria, and award grants through executed contracts. All plans
- 4 and work performed under a grant shall be consistent with the
- 5 United States secretary of the interior's standards for rehabili-
- 6 tation and guidelines for rehabilitating historic buildings, 36
- 7 C.F.R. 67, historic preservation certifications.
- **8** (5) Lighthouse fund-raising registration plate donations
- 9 collected under section 811f and matching lighthouse collector
- 10 plate fund-raising donations collected under section 811g shall
- 11 be transferred under section $\frac{811m}{100}$ 811H by the secretary of
- 12 state to the state treasurer, who shall credit the donation money
- 13 to the Michigan lighthouse preservation grant fund for the pre-
- 14 servation of historic Michigan lighthouses.
- 15 (6) For purposes of this chapter, "state-sponsored light-
- 16 house fund-raising registration plate" means a registration plate
- 17 containing a specialized design pertaining to historic Michigan
- 18 lighthouses.
