- 3 DOMESTIC VIOLENCE, THE COURT SHALL CONSIDER THE SAFETY OF ANY
- 4 ALLEGED VICTIM OR POTENTIAL VICTIM OF THE DOMESTIC VIOLENCE IN
- 5 DETERMINING WHETHER GOOD CAUSE FOR SEALING THE RECORDS HAS BEEN
- 6 SHOWN.
- 7 (2) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "DOMESTIC VIOLENCE" MEANS THAT
- 8 TERM AS DEFINED IN SECTION 1 OF 1978 PA 389, MCL 400.1501.
