HOUSE BILL NO. 5370

- 15 nue bonds. The loan revenue bonds are declared to be issued for
- 16 an essential public and governmental purpose, and, together with
- 17 interest on those bonds and income from those bonds, shall be
- 18 exempted from all taxes.
