A bill to amend 1986 PA 255, entitled "Prepaid funeral contract funding act," by amending section 19 (MCL 328.229).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 19. (1) A prepaid funeral contract may be made with an
- 2 applicant for or recipient of assistance under the social welfare
