SENATE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 4718

A bill to amend 1893 PA 206, entitled "The general property tax act,"

by amending section 78i (MCL 211.78i), as added by 1999 PA 123.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 78i. (1) Not later than May 1 immediately succeeding
- 2 the forfeiture of property to the county treasurer under section
- 3 78g, the foreclosing governmental unit shall -conduct INITIATE a
- 4 title search to identify the owners of a property interest in the
- 5 property who are entitled to notice under this section of the
- 6 show cause hearing under section 78j and the foreclosure hearing
- 7 under section 78k. The foreclosing governmental unit may enter
- 8 into a contract with 1 or more title insurance companies or
- 9 agents licensed to conduct business in this state AUTHORIZED
- 10 REPRESENTATIVES to perform the title search required under this

- 1 subsection and to perform the other functions set forth in this 2 section.
- 3 (2) The foreclosing governmental unit or its authorized rep-
- 4 resentative shall determine the address reasonably calculated to
- 5 apprise those owners of a property interest of the pendency of
- 6 the show cause hearing under section 78j and the foreclosure
- 7 hearing under section 78k and shall send notice of the show cause
- 8 hearing under section 78j and the foreclosure hearing under
- 9 section 78k to those owners, to a person entitled to notice of
- 10 the return of delinquent taxes under section 78a(4), and to a
- 11 person to whom a tax deed for property returned for delinquent
- 12 taxes was issued pursuant to section 72 as determined by the
- 13 records of the state treasurer, by certified mail, return receipt
- 14 requested, not less than 30 days before the show cause hearing.
- 15 The failure of the foreclosing governmental unit to comply with
- 16 any provision of this section shall not invalidate any proceeding
- 17 under this act if the owner of a property interest or a person to
- 18 whom a tax deed was issued is accorded the minimum due process
- 19 required under the state constitution of 1963 and the constitu-
- 20 tion of the United States.
- 21 (3) The foreclosing governmental unit or its authorized rep-
- 22 resentative shall make a personal visit to each parcel of prop-
- 23 erty forfeited to the county treasurer under section 78g to
- 24 ascertain whether or not the property is occupied. If the prop-
- 25 erty appears to be occupied, the foreclosing governmental unit or
- 26 its authorized representative shall do all of the following:

- 1 (a) Attempt to personally serve upon a person occupying the
- 2 property a copy of a notice of the show cause hearing under
- 3 section 78j and the foreclosure hearing under section 78k.
- 4 (b) If a person occupying the property is personally served,
- 5 orally inform the occupant that the property will be foreclosed
- 6 and the occupants will be required to vacate unless all forfeited
- 7 unpaid delinquent taxes, interest, penalties, and fees are paid,
- 8 of the time within which all forfeited unpaid delinquent taxes,
- 9 interest, penalties, and fees must be paid, and of agencies or
- 10 other resources that may be available to assist the owner to
- 11 avoid loss of the property.
- 12 (c) If the occupant appears to lack the ability to under-
- 13 stand the advice given, notify the family independence agency or
- 14 provide the occupant with the names and telephone number of the
- 15 agencies that may be able to assist the occupant.
- 16 (d) If the foreclosing governmental unit or its authorized
- 17 representative is not able to personally meet with the occupant,
- 18 the foreclosing governmental unit or its authorized representa-
- 19 tive shall place the notice in a conspicuous manner on the prop-
- 20 erty and shall also place in a conspicuous manner on the property
- 21 a notice that explains, in plain English, that the property will
- 22 be foreclosed unless forfeited unpaid delinquent taxes,
- 23 penalties, interest, PENALTIES, and fees are paid, the time
- 24 within which forfeited unpaid delinquent taxes, interest, penal-
- 25 ties, and fees must be paid, and the names, addresses, and tele-
- 26 phone numbers of agencies or other resources that may be
- 27 available to assist the occupant to avoid loss of the property.

House Bill No. 4718 1 If this state is the foreclosing governmental unit within a 2 county, the department of natural resources shall perform the 3 personal visit to each parcel of property under this subsection 4 on behalf of this state. (4) The foreclosing governmental unit or its authorized 6 representative shall record the proof of service of the notice of 7 the show cause hearing under section 78j, the foreclosure hearing 8 under section 78k, and the personal visit to the property 9 required under this section with the register of deeds in the 10 county in which the property is located. 11 (4) (5) If the foreclosing governmental unit entered into a 12 contract with a title insurance company or agent licensed to do 13 business in this state under subsection (1), the foreclosing gov-14 ernmental unit shall provide the proof of service recorded under 15 subsection (4) to the title insurance company or agent. If 21 the foreclosing governmental unit is notified of OR ITS AUTHO-22 RIZED REPRESENTATIVE DISCOVERS any deficiency in -service THE 23 PROVISION OF NOTICE, the foreclosing governmental unit shall TAKE 24 REASONABLE STEPS IN GOOD FAITH TO correct that deficiency and 25 provide proof of that correction to the title insurance company

26 or agent NOT LATER THAN 30 DAYS BEFORE THE SHOW CAUSE HEARING

- 6 by publication. The A notice shall be published for 3 succes-
- 7 sive weeks, once each week, in a newspaper published and circu-
- 8 lated in the county in which the property is located, if there is
- **9** one. If no paper is published in that county, publication shall
- 10 be made in a newspaper published and circulated in an adjoining
- 11 county. -, and proof of publication, by affidavit of the printer

- 2 (B) THE STREET ADDRESS OF EACH PROPERTY, IF POSSIBLE.
- 3 (C) THE NAME OF ANY PERSON OR ENTITY ENTITLED TO NOTICE
- 4 UNDER THIS SECTION WHO HAS NOT BEEN NOTIFIED UNDER SUBSECTION (1)
- **5** OR (3).
- 6 (D) THE DATE AND TIME OF THE SHOW CAUSE HEARING UNDER
- 7 SECTION 78J.
- 8 (E) THE DATE AND TIME OF THE HEARING ON THE PETITION FOR
- 9 FORECLOSURE UNDER SECTION 78K.
- 10 (F) A STATEMENT THAT UNLESS ALL FORFEITED UNPAID DELINQUENT
- 11 TAXES, INTEREST, PENALTIES, AND FEES ARE PAID WITHIN 21 DAYS
- 12 AFTER JUDGMENT IS ENTERED IN THE FORECLOSURE PROCEEDING UNDER
- 13 SECTION 78K, THE TITLE TO THE PROPERTY SHALL VEST ABSOLUTELY IN
- 14 THE FORECLOSING GOVERNMENTAL UNIT.
- 15 (G) A STATEMENT THAT A PERSON WITH AN INTEREST IN THE PROP-
- 16 ERTY MAY LOSE HIS OR HER INTEREST IN THE PROPERTY AS A RESULT OF
- 17 THE FORECLOSURE PROCEEDING UNDER SECTION 78K.
- 18 (9) The owner of a property interest who has been properly
- 19 served with a notice of the show cause hearing under section 78j
- 20 and the foreclosure hearing under section 78k and who failed to
- 21 redeem the property as provided under this act shall not assert
- 22 any of the following:
- (a) That notice was insufficient or inadequate on the
- 24 grounds that some other owner of a property interest was not also
- 25 served.

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- (b) That the redemption period provided under this act was
- 2 extended in any way on the grounds that some other owner of a
- 3 property interest was not also served.
- (10) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE"
- 5 INCLUDES ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
- (A) A TITLE INSURANCE COMPANY OR AGENT LICENSED TO CONDUCT
- 7 BUSINESS IN THIS STATE.
- (B) AN ATTORNEY LICENSED TO PRACTICE LAW IN THIS STATE.
- 9 (C) A PERSON ACCREDITED IN TITLE SEARCH PROCEDURES BY A
- 10 NATIONALLY RECOGNIZED ORGANIZATION IN THE FIELD OF TITLE
- 11 SEARCHING.
- 12 (D) A PERSON WITH DEMONSTRATED EXPERIENCE IN THE FIELD OF
- 13 TITLE SEARCHING, AS DETERMINED BY THE FORECLOSING GOVERNMENTAL UNIT.
