HOUSE BILL NO. 4946

(As passed the House, June 28, 2001)

A bill to amend 1975 PA 197, entitled

"An act to provide for the establishment of a downtown development authority; to prescribe its powers and duties; to correct and prevent deterioration in business districts; to encourage historic preservation; to authorize the acquisition and disposal of interests in real and personal property; to authorize the creation and implementation of development plans in the districts; to promote the economic growth of the districts; to create a board; to prescribe its powers and duties; to authorize the levy and collection of taxes; to authorize the issuance of bonds and other evidences of indebtedness; to authorize the use of tax increment financing; to reimburse downtown development authorities for certain losses of tax increment revenues; and to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state officials,"

by amending section 29 (MCL 125.1679).

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1       Sec. 29. (1) A public facility, building, or structure  
2 ~~which~~ THAT is determined by the municipality to have signifi-  
3 cant historical interests shall be preserved in a manner as  
4 ~~deemed~~ CONSIDERED necessary by the municipality in accordance  
5 with laws relative to the preservation of historical sites.
