SENATE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 5091

A bill to strongly encourage state agencies and units of local government to exercise their constitutional ability to place the national motto in or on public buildings or land in this state.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. As used in this act:
- 2 (a) "State agency" means a department, board, commission,

- 4 State agency includes a state institution of higher education.
- 5 (b) "Unit of local government" means a political subdivision

- 9 political subdivision has as its primary purpose the providing of
- 10 local governmental service for citizens in a geographically
