A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled "The revised school code," (MCL 380.1 to 380.1852) by adding section 1139.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 1139. (1) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION
- 2 (2), THE SCHOOL OFFICIALS OF A PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOL SHALL PROVIDE
- 3 AT LEAST THE SAME ACCESS TO THE HIGH SCHOOL CAMPUS AND TO PUPIL
- 4 DIRECTORY INFORMATION OF THE PUPILS ENROLLED IN THE HIGH SCHOOL
- 5 AS IS PROVIDED TO OTHER ENTITIES OFFERING EDUCATIONAL OR EMPLOY-
- 6 MENT OPPORTUNITIES TO OFFICIAL RECRUITING REPRESENTATIVES OF ALL
- 7 OF THE FOLLOWING FOR THE PURPOSE OF INFORMING PUPILS OF EDUCA-
- 8 TIONAL AND CAREER OPPORTUNITIES AVAILABLE IN THE FOLLOWING:
- 9 (A) THE ARMED FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES.

- 17 (B) "PUPIL DIRECTORY INFORMATION" MEANS A PUPIL'S NAME AND
- 18 ADDRESS AND, IF IT IS A LISTED OR PUBLISHED TELEPHONE NUMBER, THE
- 19 PUPIL'S TELEPHONE NUMBER.
