# SENATE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 5341

A bill to commission and confer certain police and arrest powers on certain sergeants at arms and assistant sergeants at arms in the legislative branch; to prescribe certain duties and responsibilities of certain state employees; and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

#### THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the
- 2 "legislative sergeant at arms police powers act".
- 3 Sec. 2. (1) Each house of the legislature may commission
- 4 the sergeant at arms and may commission 1 or more assistant ser-
- 5 geants at arms within that respective house as police officers,
- 6 to enforce rules adopted by that house and the laws of this state
- 7 as designated by the senate and the house of representatives,
- 8 respectively. In performing those enforcement activities,
- 9 commissioned sergeants at arms and assistant sergeants at arms

- 1 are vested with the powers, privileges, prerogatives, and
- 2 immunities conferred upon police officers under the laws of this

- 17 (e) Areas immediately adjacent to the places described in

- 19 (3) A sergeant at arms or assistant sergeant at arms commis-
- 20 sioned as a police officer under this act shall exercise his or
- 21 her authority as a police officer at the locations specified in
- 22 subsection (2)(c) only while actually engaging in his or her
- 23 duties as the sergeant at arms or an assistant sergeant at arms
- 24 under the rules adopted by the senate or the house of representa-
- 25 tives respectively.
- 26 (4) The senate may delegate, pursuant to rules of the
- 27 senate, the authority to commission the sergeant at arms or

- 1 assistant sergeants at arms as police officers and delegate their
- 2 responsibilities under subsection (1) to the senate majority
- 3 leader, the secretary of the senate, or other officers or employ-
- 4 ees of the senate.
- 5 (5) The house of representatives may delegate, pursuant to
- 6 rules of the house of representatives, the authority to commis-
- 7 sion the sergeant at arms or assistant sergeants at arms as
- 8 police officers and delegate their responsibilities under subsec-
- 9 tion (1) to the speaker of the house of representatives, the
- 10 clerk of the house of representatives, or other officers or
- 11 employees of the house of representatives.
- 12 (6) The office of sergeant at arms of each house of the leg-
- 13 islature is a law enforcement agency of this state.
- 14 (7) A sergeant at arms or an assistant sergeant at arms com-
- 15 missioned as a police officer under this act is subject to the
- 16 training and certification requirements under the commission on
- 17 law enforcement standards act, 1965 PA 203, MCL 28.601 to
- **18** 28.616.
- 19 (8) At least once per legislative session, the individual
- 20 designated to supervise the sergeants at arms under house rules
- 21 and the individual designated to supervise the sergeants at arms
- 22 under senate rules, or their designees, shall report to the house
- 23 oversight and operations committee and the senate government
- 24 operations committee on the activities of the sergeants at arms
- 25 and other matters of interest involving the security and decorum
- 26 in their respective houses.
