THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 212a. (1) If a person violates this chapter AND

- 4 vidual or results in serious impairment of a body function of
- 5 another individual, the person is guilty of a felony punishable
- 6 by imprisonment for not more than 20 years. A THE COURT MAY
