# SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 5600

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code," by amending section 479 (MCL 750.479).

### THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 479. (1) Resisting, etc., officer in discharge of
- 2 duty--Any A person who shall NOT knowingly and wilfully
- 3 obstruct DO ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 4 (A) OBSTRUCT, resist, or oppose, any OR ENDANGER A sher-
- 5 iff, -coroner MEDICAL EXAMINER, township treasurer, constable,
- 6 OR A JUDGE, MAGISTRATE, PROBATION OFFICER, PAROLE OFFICER, PROSE-
- 7 CUTOR, CITY ATTORNEY, OR COURT EMPLOYEE or other officer or
- 8 person duly authorized —, in PERSON serving —, or attempting
- 9 to serve or execute any process, rule, or order made or issued by
- 10 lawful authority. -, or who shall resist any

- 19 serve the peace in their THE PERFORMANCE OF HIS OR HER
- 20 DUTIES OR HIS OR HER lawful acts, attempts, and OR efforts to

- 22 (E) ASSAULT, BEAT, OR WOUND ANY INDIVIDUAL DESCRIBED IN THIS

- 17 (4) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION AND BY THAT VIOLATION
- 18 INFLICTS SERIOUS INJURY ON OR CAUSES A SUBSTANTIAL RISK OF [SERIOUS] INJURY
- 19 OR DEATH TO AN INDIVIDUAL DESCRIBED IN THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF
- 20 A FELONY PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 10 YEARS OR
- 21 A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$10,000.00, OR BOTH.
- 22 (5) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION AND BY THAT VIOLATION
- 23 CAUSES THE DEATH OF ANOTHER INDIVIDUAL DESCRIBED IN THIS SECTION
- 24 IS GUILTY OF A FELONY PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE
- 25 THAN 20 YEARS OR A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$15,000.00, OR BOTH.

- 12 (C) "SERIOUS INJURY" MEANS THAT TERM AS DEFINED IN SECTION
- **13** 479A.
- 14 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect July
- **15** 1, 2002.
- 16 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take
- 17 effect unless House Bill No. 5442 of the 91st Legislature is
- 18 enacted into law.
