Sec. 514. (1) If a savings bank is required to file a

- $oldsymbol{4}$  ACTIVITY REPORT WITH AN AGENCY OF THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT, the
- 5 savings bank shall also within 24 hours file a copy of the
- 6 transaction SUSPICIOUS ACTIVITY report with the department of7 state police.
  - (2) THE SAVINGS BANK MAY FILE THE SUSPICIOUS ACTIVITY REPORT
  - AS REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (1) IN ANY MANNER THAT IS ALLOWED BY
  - FEDERAL LAW OR REGULATION [OR IN ANY MANNER THAT IS ACCEPTABLE TO THE STATE POLICE].
