- 5 Sec. 1. The board of trustees with the approval of the gov-
- 6 erning body of the COUNTY, city, village, or township of any
- 7 police and firemen or RETIREMENT SYSTEM, municipal employees
- 8 retirement system, OR COUNTY RETIREMENT SYSTEM may use not more
- 9 than 1/2 of the interest earned by any reserve fund in the system

- 1 to contract for medical, hospital or nursing care for any person
- 2 receiving benefits of the system. "Reserve fund" means the
- 3 moneys MONEY contributed by the city, village, or township,
- 4 OR COUNTY.
- 5 Sec. 2. The amount of interest used according to the provi-
- 6 sions of this act shall be included as interest and other earn-
- 7 ings on the money of the retirement system in the computation of
- 8 any city, village, or township, OR COUNTY liability for regular
- 9 interest. These supplemental benefits shall not be considered an
- 10 increase in the rate of retirement allowances to be paid. They
- 11 shall be on a year-to-year basis and shall not create a liability
- 12 for their continuance.
