

HOUSE BILL No. 5613

(As passed the Senate, May 9, 2002)

February 12, 2002, Introduced by Rep. Patterson and referred to the Committee on House Oversight and Operations.

A bill to amend 1872 PA 62, entitled

"An act regulating trials of impeachment and providing for the expenses thereof,"

by amending section 15 (MCL 6.15).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 15. The presiding officer and members of the senate,
2 while sitting as a court of impeachment, and the managers elected
3 by the house, shall receive the sum of 5 dollars each per day,
4 and mileage at the rate of 10 cents per mile in going from and
5 returning to their places of residence by the ordinarily traveled
6 routes; and the compensation of the secretary, sergeant-at-arms,
7 and all subordinate officers, clerks, and reporters, shall be
8 ~~such~~ an amount as shall be ~~fixed~~ ESTABLISHED by the vote of
9 the members of ~~such~~ THE court. The state treasurer shall, upon
10 presentation of a certificate or certificates signed by the
