## SENATE SUBSTITUTE FOR

HOUSE BILL NO. 6202
(As amended by the Senate, December 12, 2002)

A bill to amend 1973 PA 116, entitled

"An act to provide for the protection of children through the licensing and regulation of child care organizations; to provide for the establishment of standards of care for child care organizations; to prescribe powers and duties of certain departments of this state and adoption facilitators; to provide penalties; and to repeal acts and parts of acts,"

(MCL 722.111 to 722.128) by adding section 9.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 9. (1) A STAFF MEMBER SHALL NOT BE PRESENT IN A CHILD
- 2 CARE CENTER, CHILD CARING INSTITUTION, OR CHILD PLACING AGENCY IF
- 3 HE OR SHE HAS BEEN CONVICTED OF EITHER OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 4 (A) CHILD ABUSE OR CHILD NEGLECT.
- 5 (B) A FELONY INVOLVING HARM OR THREATENED HARM TO AN INDI-
- 6 VIDUAL WITHIN THE 10 YEARS IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING THE DATE OF
- 7 HIRE.

- 21 THE DATE ON WHICH THAT CHILD CARE CENTER'S, CHILD CARING
- 22 INSTITUTION'S, OR CHILD PLACING AGENCY'S LICENSE IS ISSUED OR
- 23 FIRST RENEWED AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE AMENDATORY ACT THAT
- 24 ADDED THIS SECTION. AS USED IN THIS SUBSECTION, "CHILD ABUSE"
- 25 AND "CHILD NEGLECT" MEAN THOSE TERMS AS DEFINED IN SECTION 2 OF
- 26 THE CHILD PROTECTION LAW, 1975 PA 238, MCL 722.622.

- 1 (4) EACH CHILD CARE CENTER, CHILD CARING INSTITUTION, OR
- 2 CHILD PLACING AGENCY SHALL ESTABLISH AND MAINTAIN A POLICY
- 3 REGARDING SUPERVISION OF VOLUNTEERS INCLUDING VOLUNTEERS WHO ARE
- 4 PARENTS OF A CHILD RECEIVING CARE AT THE CHILD CARE CENTER, CHILD
- 5 CARING INSTITUTION, OR CHILD PLACING AGENCY.
