A bill to prescribe the Amber alert of Michigan as the official response to reports of child abductions.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the
2 "Michigan Amber alert act".

3 Sec. 2. (1) The department of state police shall establish
4 and maintain the Michigan Amber alert plan.

5 (2) The Michigan Amber alert plan shall be designed to rap-
6 idly disseminate useful information in a predetermined manner to
7 radio and television stations within this state.

8 Sec. 3. The Michigan Amber alert plan shall be activated
9 only in accordance with the policies established by the depart-
10 ment of state police.

11 Enacting section 1. This act does not take effect unless
12 House Bill No. 6445 of the 91st Legislature is enacted into law.
