# A bill to amend 1966 PA 261, entitled

"An act to provide for the apportionment of county boards of commissioners; to prescribe the size of the board; to provide for appeals; to prescribe the manner of election of the members of the county board of commissioners; to provide for compensation of members; to prescribe penalties and provide remedies; and to repeal acts and parts of acts,"

by amending section 11 (MCL 46.411), as amended by 1982 PA 504.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 11. Candidates— A CANDIDATE for the office of COUNTY
- 2 commissioner shall be <del>residents</del> A RESIDENT and registered
- 3 voters VOTER of the district which they seek THAT HE OR SHE
- 4 SEEKS to represent and shall remain —so— A RESIDENT AND REGIS-
- 5 TERED VOTER to hold their HIS OR HER office, if elected.
- 6 Nominations and elections for commissioners shall be by partisan
- 7 elections. To obtain the printing of IN ORDER FOR the name of
- 8 any person as a candidate for nomination for the office of
