A bill to amend 1935 PA 120, entitled

"An act to prescribe a method for the fingerprinting of residents of the state, and to provide for the recording and filing thereof by the central records division of the department of state police,"

by amending section 3 (MCL 28.273), as added by 1985 PA 175.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 3. (1) The department of state police may charge a

- processing the impression of the fingerprints and completing a
- criminal record check on that person. The fee shall be collected
