(As passed the Senate February 6, 2002)

A bill to amend 1927 PA 175, entitled  
"The code of criminal procedure,"  
by amending section 19f of chapter VII (MCL 767.19f).

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1 CHAPTER VII

2 Sec. 19f. (1) Except as otherwise provided by law, ~~it is~~  
3 ~~unlawful for any~~ A person ~~to~~ SHALL NOT publish or make known  
4 to any other person any testimony or exhibits obtained or used,  
5 or any proceeding conducted, in connection with any grand jury  
6 inquiry. ~~Any~~ A person ~~violating the provisions of~~ WHO  
7 VIOLATES this ~~section~~ SUBSECTION is guilty of a misdemeanor  
8 punishable by imprisonment in the county jail for not more than 1  
9 year or by a fine of not more than \$1,000.00, or both. ~~The~~  
10 ~~provisions of this section respecting secrecy shall~~

12           (3) SUBSECTION (1) APPLIES TO, BUT ITS APPLICATION IS NOT  
13 LIMITED TO, applications and petitions for and orders of immunity  
14 and to any transcript of testimony ~~which~~ THAT may be delivered  
15 to a witness pursuant to his ~~being granted~~ OR HER GRANT OF  
16 immunity, except that the witness may be privileged to disclose  
17 such application, petition, order, and transcript to his OR HER  
18 attorney.

[Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect May 1, 2002.]

19           Enacting section [2]. This amendatory act does not take  
20 effect unless Senate Bill No. 930 of the 91st Legislature is  
21 enacted into law.
