- 6 ELECTION HELD UNDER THIS ACT SHALL BE HELD ON 1 OF THE FOLLOWING
- 7 STANDARD ELECTION DAYS:
- 8 (A) FEBRUARY ELECTION DAY, WHICH IS THE FOURTH TUESDAY IN

- 10 (B) MAY ELECTION DAY, WHICH IS THE FIRST TUESDAY AFTER THE
- 11 FIRST MONDAY IN MAY.
