SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 472

A bill to amend 1982 PA 249, entitled

"An act to establish the state children's trust fund in the department of treasury; and to provide certain powers and duties of the department of treasury with respect to the trust fund,"

by amending section 1 (MCL 21.171), as amended by 2000 PA 72.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 1. (1) The children's trust fund is created as a sepa-
- 2 rate CHARITABLE AND EDUCATIONAL ENDOWMENT fund in the department of treasury. The fund shall be
 3 expended only as provided in this section.
- (2) The state treasurer shall credit to the trust fund all
- 5 amounts appropriated for this purpose under section 475 of the
- 6 income tax act of 1967, 1967 PA 281, MCL 206.475, any amounts
- 7 received under section 811j of the Michigan vehicle code, 1949
- 8 PA 300, MCL 257.811j, and section 8 of the child abuse and
- 9 neglect prevention act, 1982 PA 250, MCL 722.608, and any amounts

- 11 (4) Until the total amount of assets in the trust fund

- 14 credited to the trust fund during the previous fiscal year, shall
- 15 be available for disbursement upon the authorization of the state
- 16 board as provided in section 9 of the child abuse and neglect
- 17 prevention act, 1982 PA 250, MCL 722.609. If the state treasurer
- 18 certifies that the assets in the trust fund exceed
- 19 \$20,000,000.00, only the INTEREST AND earnings credited to the
