

**SUBSTITUTE FOR  
SENATE BILL NO. 677**

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled  
"Michigan vehicle code,"  
by amending section 629e (MCL 257.629e), as amended by 2000  
PA 268.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1       Sec. 629e. (1) In addition to any fine or cost ordered to  
2 be paid under this act, and in addition to any assessment levied  
3 under section 907, the judge, district or municipal court refer-  
4 ee, or district or municipal court magistrate shall levy a high-  
5 way safety assessment of \$5.00, A JAIL REIMBURSEMENT PROGRAM  
6 ASSESSMENT OF \$5.00, and a secondary road patrol and training  
7 assessment of ~~-\$5.00~~ \$10.00 for each civil infraction determina-  
8 tion except for a parking violation or a violation for which the  
9 total fine and costs imposed are \$10.00 or less. Upon payment of  
10 the assessments, the clerk of the court shall transmit the

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1 assessments levied to the department of treasury. The state  
2 treasurer shall deposit the revenue received pursuant to this  
3 subsection in the highway safety fund, THE JAIL REIMBURSEMENT  
4 PROGRAM FUND, and in the secondary road patrol and training fund,  
5 and shall report annually to the legislature all revenues  
6 received and disbursed under this section. An assessment levied  
7 under this subsection shall not be considered a civil fine for  
8 purposes of section 909.

9       (2) A highway safety fund, A JAIL REIMBURSEMENT PROGRAM  
10 FUND, and a secondary road patrol and training fund are created  
11 in the department of treasury. The ~~funds~~ HIGHWAY SAFETY FUND  
12 shall be administered by the department of state police. THE  
13 JAIL REIMBURSEMENT PROGRAM FUND SHALL BE ADMINISTERED BY THE  
14 DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS. THE SECONDARY ROAD PATROL AND TRAIN-  
15 ING FUND SHALL BE ADMINISTERED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF MANAGEMENT  
16 AND BUDGET. Money collected under subsection (1) shall be depos-  
17 ited in the respective funds as provided in subsection (1). The  
18 money deposited in the highway safety fund shall serve as a sup-  
19 plement to, and not as a replacement for, the funds budgeted for  
20 the department of state police. The money in the highway safety  
21 fund shall be used by the department of state police for the  
22 employment of additional state police enlisted personnel to  
23 enforce the traffic laws on the highways and freeways of this  
24 state. THE MONEY IN THE JAIL REIMBURSEMENT PROGRAM FUND SHALL BE  
25 USED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS TO REIMBURSE COUNTIES FOR  
26 HOUSING AND CUSTODY OF CONVICTED FELONS. The money in the  
27 secondary road patrol and training fund shall be used for

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1 secondary road patrol and traffic accident grants pursuant to  
2 section 77 of 1846 RS 14, MCL 51.77, and for grants under  
3 section 14 of the commission on law enforcement standards act,  
4 1965 PA 203, MCL 28.614. IF THE REVENUE RECEIVED FROM THE \$10.00  
5 ASSESSMENT FOR SECONDARY ROAD PATROL AND TRAINING FOR A FISCAL  
6 YEAR INCREASES THE TOTAL REVENUE RECEIVED FROM ALL SOURCES FOR  
7 THE SECONDARY ROAD PATROL AND TRAINING FUND FOR THAT FISCAL YEAR,  
8 THEN THE GENERAL FUND APPROPRIATION SHALL BE REDUCED PROPORTION-  
9 ALLY TO THE ADDITIONAL REVENUE COLLECTED AND REMITTED AS A RESULT  
10 OF THE INCREASED ASSESSMENT. The department of state police, THE  
11 DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS, AND THE DEPARTMENT OF MANAGEMENT AND  
12 BUDGET shall report annually to the legislature all revenues  
13 received and disbursed under this section.
